

a BAHN is a Luxembourg-based audiovisual production company with a solid European and international reputation thanks to bold projects mixing innovation with traditional cinema. Since its inception, a BAHN has been shaking up the audiovisual production industry by developing a strategy of creative and industrial innovation.

Hybridisation, social impact, innovation are always at the heart of our editorial choices. This has enabled us to have a strong and coherent editorial line, as we produced, among other, the highly-acclaimed animated film Zero Impunity by Blies Brothers (2019, Annecy International Animation Film Festival, +60 festivals), Blies Brothers' transmedia Soundhunters (ARTE - 2016, nominated for the Prix Europa), VR films like 7 Lives by Jan Kounen (2019, Tribeca Film Festival) and Cosmos Within Us by Tupac Martir (2019, Venice International Film Festival), or more recently ARTE's hybrid documentary Monk, Pannonica, An American Story by Jacques Goldstein (released in spring 2022).

In 2023, a_BAHN will release the ambitious TV documentary series Draw For Change, a 6x52 series of portraits of women cartoonists around the world, the touring immersive experience Sex, Desire and Data, a coproduction with PHI Studio (Canada), and a 2x52 hybrid documentary by Thomas Sipp on the Barbarossa battle, in coproduction with ARTE and Les Films D'Ici.

a BAHN also works on several film developments, notably Here Lies My Heart, an XR experience by Blies Brothers, or the animated documentary Red Zone by Iryna Tsilyk (Sundance Directing Award: World Cinema Documentary), coproduced with Moon Man (Ukraine).
