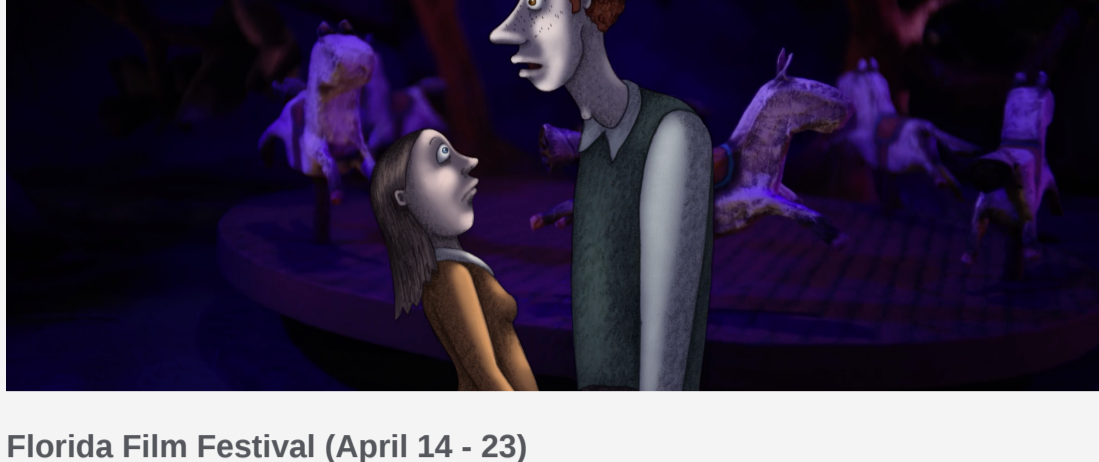


Brussels International Fantastic Film Festival (April 11 - 23)

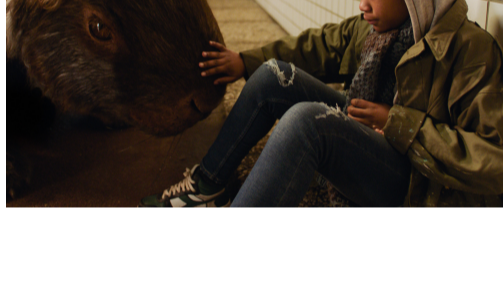

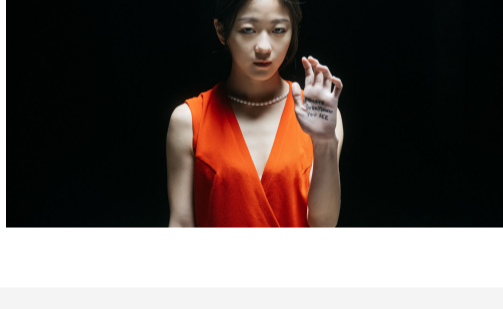

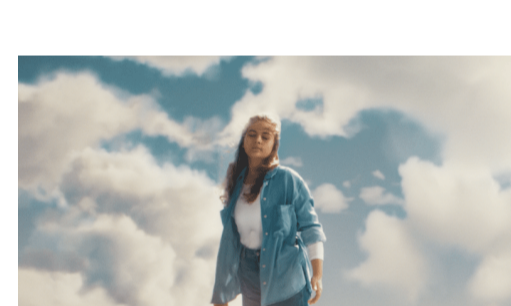
IN CINEMAS THIS MONTH

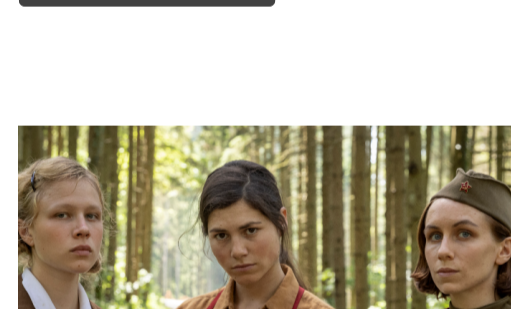

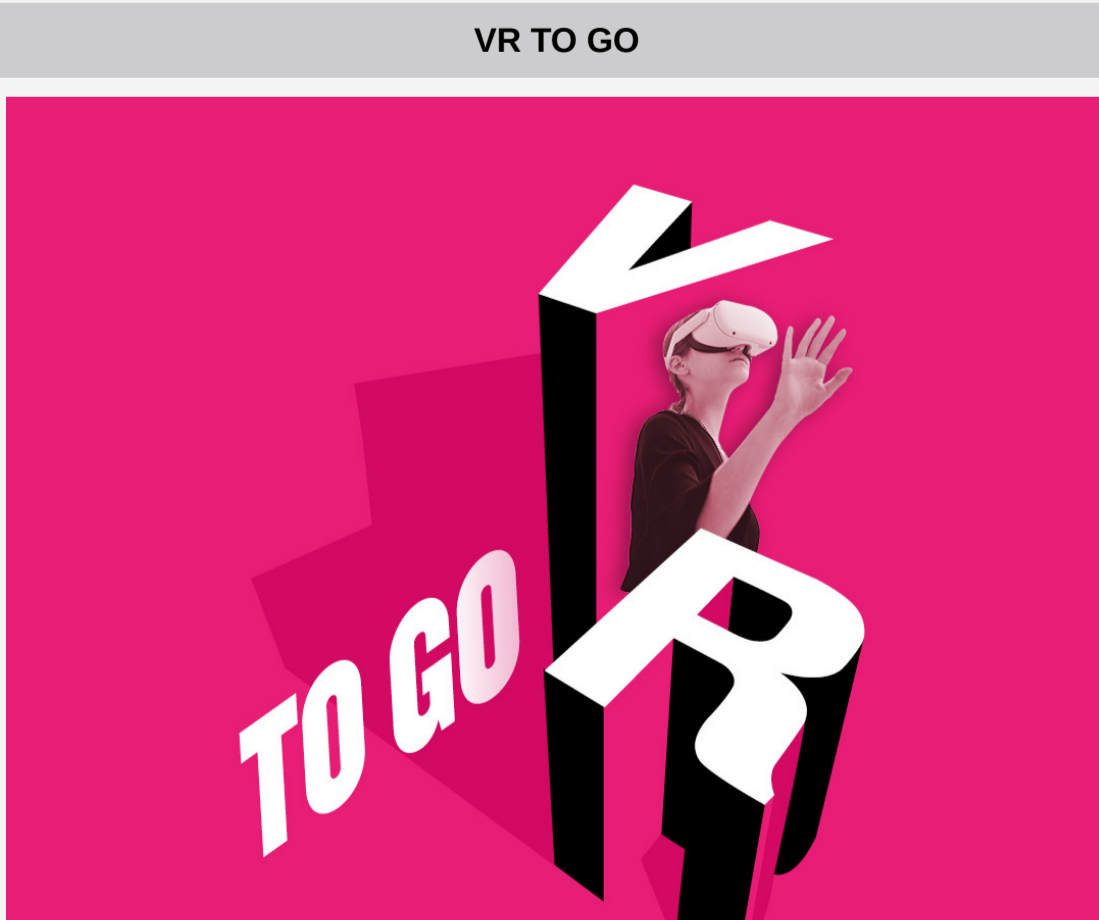


LITTLE DUKE by Andy Bausch

Prix CinEuro pour le développement de coproductions transfrontalières

CinEuro est un réseau transfrontalier de près de 40 organismes en charge du soutien à la filière cinématographique et audiovisuelle en France, au Luxembourg, en Allemagne, en Suisse et en Belgique. À partir de 2023, les partenaires de CinEuro souhaitent soutenir le développement de coproductions portant sur des récits liés aux territoires partenaires.

À cet effet, la Région Grand Est, le Film Fund Luxembourg, la Medien- und Filmgesellschaft Baden-Württemberg, la Saarland Medien GmbH, le Ministère pour la Famille, Femmes, Kultur und Integration Rheinland-Pfalz, Wallimège, screen.brussels, Wallonie-Bruxelles International et le Ministère der Deutschsprachigen Gemeinschaft Belgiens lancent conjointement le Prix CinEuro.
