## EAVE PRODUCERS WORKSHOP 2024



Train, develop, network. A year long programme focused on three intensive weeks featuring professional development through working on the development of fiction, documentary and TV series projects.

EAVE is aimed at producers (fiction, documentary and TV series), who are already working in the film and television industries who wish to expand their operation internationally by increasing their knowledge of producing and co-producing in Europe and by building up a pan European professional network. Each year fifty participants are selected from most of the EU countries and beyond and take part in three one-week long workshops.

The [Rencontres de Coproduction Francophone](#) (RCF) brings together over a hundred professionals from the film, audiovisual and immersive works industries.

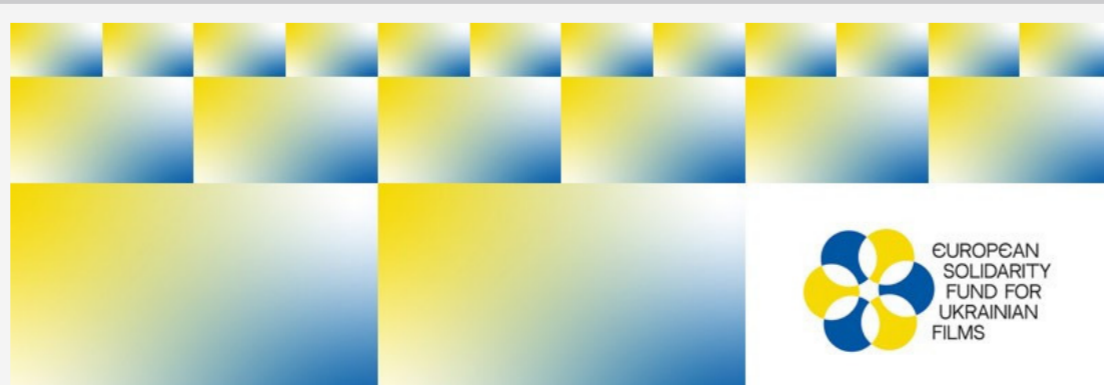
This 19th edition of the RCF will take place from 7 to 9 November 2023 in Geneva, Switzerland, as part of the Geneva International Film Festival (GIFF) and is organised by the Swiss Federal Office of Culture in collaboration with FOCAL.

25 French-language projects (feature films, TV series and immersive works) will be selected and presented in the form of a videopitch to over a hundred film industry professionals from Switzerland, Belgium, France, Luxembourg, Quebec, Canada and French-speaking Africa.

## EUROPEAN SOLIDARITY FUND FOR UKRAINIAN FILMS



The [European Solidarity Fund for Ukrainian Films](#) is an initiative launched in February 2023. After having supported various actions for Ukraine at a national and European level, [EEAD](#) and its members wanted to unite forces to launch a dedicated support for Ukrainian filmmakers, to support the completion of films or the development of new projects, while fostering co-productions.

The eligible projects should be feature-length fiction, documentary or animation projects in development or post-production directed by a Ukrainian filmmaker, intended to be released in theatres. They must be co-produced between a Ukrainian production company and one or more production companies established in the ESFUF contributing countries (Belgium, Croatia, Cyprus, Denmark, Estonia, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Lithuania, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, the United Kingdom).

Deadline for applications: September 1, 2023
